Funds available reviewed. Funds to pay for the new roof available.

Christmas tree lighting event final plans discussed; Angel is getting Boy Scouts to sing carols, and will get the word out at the schools, prep goodie bags for the children, and schedule Santa; Ben scheduling Town employees to help cut, and set up tree, and contacting media, Bunny, Pat S., and MaryBeth C. to make apple dumplings, Bunny coordinating refreshments, and other general issues re: the event.

The new roof is nearly complete, some small safety issues noted by Leadbetters were noted, and taken care of; will be complete, and clean up done by the date of the tree lighting.

A new back door has been donated by Viking Lumber, via the Historical Society. Viking will need to be added to the plaque in the building.

Status of cookbook sales is slow, but we hope to sell a few more prior to Christmas.

Ben will be meeting with an attorney soon re: the potential change in ownership to the Historical Society. Specific concerns need to be addressed re: the septic system, insurance, and survey/deed.

In new business, Ben proposed that we look into either purchasing, or soliciting a donation of a live tree to be planted in an appropriate spot in front of the Old Hall, To become a (semi) permanent Christmas tree to be enjoyed by all, saving considerable effort in the years to come. Everyone agreed that this was a great idea.
