Sherry Murray asked to pay the bill to keep website up, out of funds available.

Front door bids need to be updated, Bunny will investigate.

A new back door has been donated by the Holden Historical Society via Viking Lumber. Installation will happen in the spring, Kerry will make sure that they are thanked.

The Christmas Tree Lighting event was discussed, and all leftover food was given to the Lafayette Cancer Center, via Pat Sirois.

Cookbook sales were briefly discussed. More effort is needed to push their sales.

Possible transfer of the building to the Historical Society was discussed, no proposal to date has been received from the Town.

We will ask Ben Breadmore to inquire if the Fire Dept. Auxilliary will be having the Fall Frolic this year.

In new business it was proposed that we request a donation of a smaller live Christmas Tree to be planted at the Hall. And Bunny noted that Paul and Lolly Sevigny of the Historical Society are willing to donate funds to properly install underground electrical making the annual tree lighting event process much easier.

No date was set for the next meeting.
