The Holden Cemetery Board met at the Town Office at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Jane Black, Loretta Libby, Ellen Campbell, Bruce Dowling and Larry Varisco present.

The following fees were updated and passed unanimously:

Effective date for revised fees and receiving accounts:  
June 1, 1991 (JB/EC) Unanimously approved.

A motion (EC/LL) to delete from the Funeral Home Memo dated April 24, 1990 the regulation selling cremation lots for 50.00 passed unanimously. The remainder of the Funeral Home Memo was approved as is (LL/JB) unanimously.

FENCING: The wrought iron fencing that still remains at the Public Works grounds will be disposed of in the next few days. Peter Roderick has agreed to salvage 3 corners and 2 sections to be installed at the Pinkham lot at Hart's Corner. He will remove all remaining pieces.

The committee authorized a load of screened loam to be delivered to the Public Works grounds to be metered out and delivered by PW as needed annually to each cemetery.

The Rowe Cemetery vault doors are still a source of vandalism and should be replaced with something that has a more substantial locking mechanism. Committee members have agreed to observe other vault doors in their travels, and try to produce photographs of same.

The next meeting will be held on May 6, 1991 at 9:00 a.m.

ARTICLE 5 FEES, CHARGES AND PAYMENTS:

5.1 Prior to 1976, Holden residents were given cemetery lots free of charge. In 1976, the Cemetery Board established a policy requiring residents to purchase cemetery lots. Please be aware that even if a lot was reserved prior to 1976, it must now be paid for before it can be used.

5.2 The following schedule of fees and charges is in effect and applicable to all of the Holden Municipal Cemeteries. The payment of all fees and charges shall be made at the Holden Municipal Office where receipts and proper title will be issued for all amounts paid.

5.3 Price of Lots includes Perpetual Care.

5.4 A minimum payment of 25 percent must be received to reserve a lot, with the balance due within two years, or prior to interment, whichever comes first. Lots not fully paid for in the two year period will be subject to any price increase enacted by the Board of Cemetery Trustees.

5.5 The cost of a full interment opening during regular working hours is \$300.00, and \$350.00 at all other times. Opening for a cremation is \$50.00

ARTICLE 6 RULES and REGULATIONS

6.1 The Board of Cemetery Trustees may, and it hereby expressly reserves the right, at any time or times, with or without notice to Owners, to adopt new rules and regulations, or to amend, alter and/or repeal any rule, regulation and /or article, section, paragraph and/or sentence in these Rules and Regulations.

6.2 Copies of these Rules and Regulations shall be distributed to Owners of lots at time of purchase, to persons making general inquiries or interment arrangements, and to local funeral homes and monument companies.
