1. Opening – Jane Black opened the meeting at 4:08pm
2. Moment of Silence – A moment of silence was observed by those present
3. Approval of last meeting minutes – minutes from the March Meeting will be available for the next meeting
4. Old Business
 - A. Burton/Rowe Cemetery Access Discussion – Town Manager Breadmore updated that we have been unsuccessful securing access over Mill Stream Road. The Board suggested reaching out to abutters to gain access around the road.
 - B. Demolition of the Tomb at Rowe Cemetery – Town Manager Breadmore updated the Board that the Tomb has been demolished and the crew did a very good job.
 - C. Member recruitment – Unfortunately we have not had any new volunteers come forward to serve on the Board.
5. New Business
 - A. Proposed amendment to Rules and Regs/Ordinance – The proposed Ordinance revisions for sale of lots and no longer allowing planter pots in Holden Cemeteries was supported and will be forwarded to the Town Council for review.
 - B. Proposed amendment to the lot purchase form – The proposed changes were supported and will be made pending Town Council approval of the Rules Regs/Ordinance.
6. Other Business – Member Ellen Campbell proposed cleaning some stones and has a recommended product to utilize. Our Highway Department will be on hand next spring to assist in the cleaning.

Town Manager Breadmore and Town Councilor Thomas Copeland updated the Board that some stones have been damaged by the mowing crew and they are willing to step up to have them repaired at no cost to the town. While the stones are being repaired they will also be cleaned, cleaning will be done at the Town's expense.
